PRAYER FOR UNREACHED PEOPLES: **Nat (N) (pronounced 'not') (Muslim) in S.**

Asia: Pray for God to open hearts in this insular group to Christ; that they will hunger to access God's Word and Christian resources; and that God will send laborers whom the N will receive and hear.

DEAN BALDWIN: Faith & Farming workshops have begun; pray for good results.
